

## ABSTRACT

### EFFECTIVENESS OF VILLAGE ALLOCATION BUDGET IN SOMBA OPU SUB-DISTRICT OF GOWA REGENCY

The problem analysed in the study was about program effectiveness implementation. The objective of the study was to understand the effectiveness of village allocation budget in Somba Opu sub-district of Gowa regency.

The study applied a descriptive quantitative method. Population of the study were all 14 villages in Somba Opu sub-district of Gowa regency receiving village allocation budget. Informants of the study included head of villages, the PJOK and PJAK, the people and other stakeholders of the program.

The results of the study showed that the implementation of village allocation budget in Somba Opu sub-district had been well implemented according to procedures and rules set by Gowa regency government. However, some problems found in the implementation of the program including the ability of non-government institutions in the village. Therefore, it could be concluded that the effectiveness of the program was only adequate and the public participation affected the effectiveness of the program.
