THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GROUNDWATER PERMITS AS GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT IN THE CAR WASHING BUSINESS IN THE BIRINGKANAYA DISTRICT

A car wash business is a type of business that requires a large amount of water debit. Therefore, the industry uses drilled wells as a means of business activity. Groundwater is an action taken to meet the needs of people's lives, for daily use and even for commercial purposes. In Biringkanaya District, the average water source is from drilled wells. The increasing use of groundwater makes the quantity of groundwater decrease. Groundwater exploitation permits as a form of what can be done in carrying out the management of the use of groundwater, especially for business owners, such as the car wash business in Biringkanaya District, Makassar City, which is growing, because this business is easy to do and does not require such a large amount of investment.

Therefore, the author wants to find out how far business owners own this groundwater concession, especially the car wash business in Biringkanaya District, by using a qualitative method and seeing its implementation through the Regulation of South Sulawesi Province government Number 4 of 2019 concerning the Management and Utilization of Groundwater.

The results of this study indicate that the implementation of groundwater concession permits is far from the desired expectations. Many car wash business owners still do not have groundwater concession permits. There is still a need for coordination and synergy between the Regional Government of South Sulawesi Province and related regional apparatus. Supervision and guidance must also be strengthened to become the foundation for the success of a local government policy implementation. Other results also found that the non-ownership of this permit was due to their ignorance regarding groundwater use for business needs.
