COORDINATION TEAM (TKPK) IN DEVELOPING REGIONAL POVERTY
REDUCTION PLANS (RPKD) SOUTH SULAWESI PROVINCE**

One of the key issues that the government of every nation focuses on is poverty. More than one billion people live in developing nations, where poverty is a common way of life. Poverty is a problem brought on by both the state of a nation's economy and the state of the world. In other words, poverty is a social reality that always exists in the midst of society. It is virtually possible to say that poverty will always be a "eternal fact" in existence.

This study applied a qualitative descriptive approach. The objectives of this study guided the purposeful selection of research informants. Interviews, observations, and documentation studies were used as data gathering strategies. The triangulation of data technique was used to examine research data.

Based on the findings of the study, it was determined that the South Sulawesi Province's Poverty Reduction Coordination Team's (TKPK) ability to prepare the Regional Poverty Reduction Plan (RPKD) document has not operated at its best because of a number of issues, including: (1) a large amount of workload assigned to TKPK; (2) the function of the managerial structure in the TKPK has not been optimal so that the RPKD document has not been completed. Policy recommendations for the success of the Poverty Reduction Coordination Team's (TKPK) work in the South Sulawesi Province's Regional Poverty Reduction Plan (RPKD) document include: (1) dissolving the TKPK Team of South Sulawesi Province for the period of 2018–2023; (2) creating a Special Team to take the Chairperson's place; and (3) developing requests for direct coordination between TKPK and OPD
